(Try to find interesting things to use to dress it like - a hat, buttons, carrot, natural materials, ribbons, or spare clothing) | Try mark malking or writiong in and on the snow. You could use your feet, sticks, giont paintbrushes, pom-poms, or lolly sticks. | Draw a picture of someone dressed for a cold winter day and then label the clothes they are wearing to keep them warm and dry. |
