Make Your Own Mezuzah

Instructions for Making a Mezuzah

- 1. Cut around the edge of the two mezuzah parts by following the solid black lines.
- 2. Next, fold down the dotted lines to create hill folds.
- 3. Fold up the dashed and dotted lines to create valley folds.
- 4. Apply glue to the larger tab on the golden section and stick this to the section on the opposite side. This should begin to form the mezuzah's shape.
- 5. Apply glue to the smaller tab on the golden section and glue down inside the mezuzah to seal one end.
- 6. Place the folded plain section inside the mezuzah. This represents a piece of parchment with writing from the Torah.
- 7. Seal the final open-ended section of the mezuzah by gluing together the two triangular tabs.
